The National Air & Space Museum maintains the world's largest collection of historic aircraft and spacecraft. It is also a vital center for historical research on aviation and spaceflight and related science and technology, and home to the Center for Earth and Planetary Studies, which performs original research. You will have 2 hours to explore the National Air & Space Museum.

The group will meet for lunch at one of the museum's cafes. Then you will travel to the National Museum of the American Indian, next door. You will have 2 hours to complete your exploration of the museum. The National Museum of the American Indian cares for one of the world's most expansive collections of native objects, photographs, and media, covering the entire Western Hemisphere from the Arctic Circle to Tierra del Fuego.


**Transportation**: Drop off and pick up at the Hyatt Regency Hotel at Reagan National Airport.
