U Street Fork Tour explores a city within a city. Formerly known as Black Broadway, this neighborhood provided artists of color the opportunity to perform their works in beautiful theaters, small clubs, and little pool halls throughout the 20th century.

This tour dives into the stories of the musicians and writers that called this community home, the contributions of local and international leaders in the Civil Rights movement, and the community devastation that followed the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr. in 1968.

Delicious food tastings will highlight the transitions in the community over the past 60 years. Participants will do tastings at a minimum of 4 food spots native to the DC area.


Transportation: Drop off and pick up at the Hyatt Regency Hotel at Reagan National Airport.
