Lunch on your own in the Farmers Market area

Leave from the Hyatt on an air-conditioned coach for a tour of the Dallas area. This tour is “hop on, hop off” with time to explore and take photos. Learn about Dallas’ history, art, architecture, JFK, professional sports and parks. Tour the West End Historic District which is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places. Located within the district is Dealey Plaza, a park surrounding the original birthplace of Dallas. See the founder of Dallas, John Neely Bryan’s original Log Cabin. Dealey Plaza is also the site of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Walk through Dealey Plaza, viewing the Sixth Floor Museum and the Kennedy Memorial. Art and Architecture of the Downtown Dallas and surrounding areas will be viewed, including the AT&T Discover District. Visit the Farmers Market for a chance to stretch your legs and eat lunch on your own. The tour includes a visit to the campus of Southern Methodist University, home of the George W. Bush Presidential Center and the Meadows Museum, one of the finest collections of Spanish Art outside Spain. Please note – this is not an in-depth tour of either the JFK historical sites, or the George W. Bush Presidential Library. Those sites are visited in-depth on other tours.
