Leaving the Hyatt upon an air-conditioned coach, experience the tragedy of Friday, November 22, 1963 first hand. Follow the timeline of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Walk through Dealey Plaza as your guide explains the site, now listed as a National Historic Landmark. Pause at the Assassination Historical Marker, learning about the gunshots that were possibly fired from the sixth floor of the building then known as the Texas Schoolbook Depository by the alleged gunman Lee Harvey Oswald. Climb the Grassy Knoll, look upon the scene as viewed by witnesses, and reflect upon the impact upon the American people. See the Old Municipal Building, where during the prison transfer, Jack Ruby shot and killed the suspect Lee Harvey Oswald. View the Kennedy Memorial. Travel to the area where Oswald lived, and trace the route he took as he fled the scene.
