GLOW CONVENTION REGISTRATIONS Beginning at 12 Noon (EST) on Friday, February 5, you may begin to use the online registration system on the Golden Glow of Christmas Past (GGCP) website at GoldenGlow.org. Login and click the Annual Convention section. Glow convention registration is \$265 per person. (Look for the "What's Included in My Glow Convention Registration?" one-pager under the Annual Convention section for a summary.)

Any mailed-in registrations will not be processed until February 5 when they will be opened randomly by our Convention Registrar. One guest permitted per household membership. Children may attend, but must pay the full registration fee if occupying a banquet seat.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS Hotel reservations will begin at 12 Noon (EST) on Monday, February 8, after the Glow registration opens! You must be a paid GGCP member and registered for the convention to make a hotel reservation.

Beginning Monday, February 8, hotel reservations may be made by clicking a link that will be provided on the **Annual Convention** section at GoldenGlow.org, or by calling the Norfolk Waterside Marriott (host hotel) or the Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel (alternate hotel). Be sure to indicate which hotel you wish to stay in. (The Sheraton is a pet-friendly hotel.) You must book in the Golden Glow convention block (GGCP) to receive the Marriott group rate of \$159 per night, plus tax, available July 9-18, or the Sheraton group rate of \$149 per night, plus tax. Complimentary WiFi is included. Requests for seller rooms will be taken through the Glow convention registration form with additional information to be provided prior to the opening of the hotel reservation date.

ONLINE REGISTRATION OPENS at GoldenGlow.org on February 5 at 12 Noon (EST).

To register online, first login under MY ACCOUNT, click on the Annual Convention section, and follow the noted directions.

CONVENTION SALES ROOM All paid registered members are invited to sell in the Convention Sales Room on Saturday, July 17. Tables are available for rent on the registration form. Glow policy requires that you offer for sale pre-1982 Christmas items only. This policy will be enforced by the Vetting Committee. There will be a 30-minute pre-buying session for members who are selling before the doors open to the general membership. Setup will occur Friday night and Saturday morning before the room opens.

CHRISTKINDLMARKT This will take place on Tuesday, July 13, before the convention officially starts. Tables are available for rent on the registration form. It is an opportunity to sell hand-made holiday and Christmas items.

IN-ROOM SALES (Room Hopping) You may buy, sell or trade from your hotel room within the Marriott, but please do not sell from your room during the General Membership Meeting and the convention educational sessions/talks so that our attendees can focus on the special presentations provided by GGCP subject matter experts. Per our hotel contract, Room Sales should conclude by 10pm each night. Any holiday, new or old, can be sold from your hotel room. Please be sure to mark your registration form to indicate that you will be selling from your room and we will assign you to a selling floor. Also, indicate whether you want to rent one or more tables for your room.

OVERFLOW SALES ROOMS For GGCP members who will be staying at the Sheraton, but would like to "room hop" sell, limited shared overflow rooms are available at an additional fee. TABLE RENTALS Tables are available to rent for the In-Room Sales, Christkindlmarkt, and the Convention Sales Room. The cost is \$50 for one table or \$75 for two tables. Should you require more than two tables, please contact Richard Braddock, Co-Host, at RBraddockGGCPConvention2021@gmail.com. (You may bring your own table for In-Rooms sales only.)

HOLLY LUNCHEON The Holly Luncheon is an optional Wednesday luncheon for those who love holly Christmas china. You can bring your own holly china table setting or use the hotel's table setting. You do not have to be a "holly collector" to attend! Come learn about this timehonored part of Christmas collecting. The Holly Luncheon is hosted by our own Nancy Smith, a holly china expert. (Limited to 100 participants.)

A LIGHT LUNCH (New this year!) All are welcome to come enjoy dining and discussion with our GGCP lighting experts at this optional Tuesday luncheon. Please bring (pre-1980) lights or a lighted decoration from your collection if you want to participate in the "show and tell" portion of the luncheon. This luncheon will be hosted by Craig McManus, Editor of the GGCP magazine The GLOW, and a vintage lighting expert. (Limited to 100 participants.)

BLOW MOLD LUNCHEON (New this year!) New this year is an optional Blow Mold Luncheon on Monday. Being surrounded by these special Christmas items while you dine will surely put a smile on your face. This luncheon is hosted by one of our blow mold experts and GGCP Board member Carrie Polales Sansing. (Limited to 100 participants.)

CONVENTION PASSPORT (New this year!) Each attendee will be provided a Convention Passport. Attendees that collect the needed passport stamps may enter a drawing for a paid convention registration for Chicago 2022. A total of three paid registrations will be drawn from the completed passports.

GOLDEN GLOW CHORALE This is an a cappella choir led by our Music Director John Wernega. The Chorale performs at the Closing Banquet, as well as at other times during the convention. Please consider lending your talents for our membership to enjoy.

COOKIE CONTEST In the spirit of Christmas, we need our incredible bakers to enter our Annual Cookie Contest. Cookies will be judged in the following categories: Bars, Drop, Molded or Pressed, Refrigerator, Rolled & Cut, Candy (all types), and a regional favorite for the Commonwealth of Virginia, the Butter Cookie. Enter as many categories as you wish. For each entry, please submit one dozen (12) cookies on plates provided by the convention, and the recipe (recipe MUST be included for entry to be considered). Cookie contest kits will be available at the registration desk and may be returned there for entry. First and second prizes will be awarded in each category.

GALA HOLIDAY AUCTION (Friday, July 16) Members may buy or consign pre-1982 Christmas items ONLY. Items valued at \$100 or more will be included in the Gala Holiday Auction. Items submitted to the Auction will be subject to approval by the Auction and Vetting Committee. Submissions may be limited to 4 items per person to provide all attendees with the opportunity to submit treasures for our GGCP collector family to procure. FEES: 10% buyer, 10% seller, 4% fee to buyer for credit card charges.

SILENT AUCTION (Friday, July 16) Smaller items valued at less than \$100, are offered in a Silent Auction. A great opportunity for buyers and sellers. FEES: 10% buyer, 10% seller, 4% fee to buyer for credit card charges.

MUSEUM ROOM The Museum Room will officially open during the Museum Gala Reception on Wednesday, July 14. Our amazing Museum Room will be open extended hours during the convention to allow our members to spend quality time viewing the special collections presented with love by our fellow GGCP members.

If you wish to participate in the Museum Room with a showcase display and/or a "Picture This" display, you must complete and return as directed the appropriate display form located on GoldenGlow.org under the Annual Convention section.
