DALLAS CONVENTION REGISTRATION begins at 12 Noon (EST) on Friday, February 2, 2024, when the online registration system opens on the Golden Glow of Christmas Past (GGCP) website GoldenGlow.org/Convention-44

Dallas Convention registration is \$395 per person. Look for the "What's included in my Golden Glow Convention Registration?" one-pager in the Annual Convention section.

Mailed-in registrations will not be processed until February 2, when they will be opened randomly by the Convention Registrar. One paying guest is permitted per household membership. Children may attend, but must pay the full registration fee if occupying a banquet seat at any time during the Golden Glow Convention.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS begin at 12 Noon (EST) on Monday, February 5, 2024. You must be a paid GGCP member and registered for the convention to make a hotel reservation at the GGCP rate.

To make a hotel reservation, click the link on GoldenGlow.org/ Convention-44 or call the Hyatt Regency Dallas, Reunion Tower at (800) 233-1234 and ask for the GGCP rate. You must book in the Golden Glow convention block to receive the group rate of \$159 per night, plus tax, available August 1 - 11. A few larger rooms will be available online at a higher cost. Group rates will be available until Friday, July 12, 2024.

WiFi is included and the Hyatt is a pet-friendly hotel. Check the hotel's website for their pet policy. Requests for seller rooms will only be taken through the Golden Glow online registration system or paper registration form. The hotel will not assign the selling floors.

Self-parking is \$12/day either in the hotel garage and/or a surface lot within walking distance with in/out privileges.
