"With its state-of-the-art interactive exhibits, the George W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum gives visitors an in-depth look at 8 years of American history, the American Presidency, and important issues of public policy."

Depart by air conditioned coach to the campus of Southern Methodist University for your tour of the George W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum, America's 13th Presidential Library, which opened to the public on May 1, 2013, and is overseen by the National Archives and Records Administration.

Exhibits feature events during the term of our nation's 43rd President, focusing extensively on the events of 9/11. A model of the Oval Office during his tenure is a featured attraction, as is the gown worn by Laura Bush to the President's Inaugural Balls.

The grounds of the Library are set in a native Texas landscape, featuring plants to attract pollinators and birds. On your way back to the hotel, enjoy a brief driving tour of SMU, a nationally ranked private university founded in 1911.
