Enjoy a warm Texas welcome and leisurely stroll along Grapevine's picturesque "Main Street Historic District" and learn about its fascinating past. Grapevine's Historic Main Street District is the oldest settlement in Tarrant County, originating under the Lone Star flag of the Republic of Texas in 1844, a year before Texas was annexed by the United States of America. Come stroll through time, learn and explore on a guided tour of Grapevine's history and heritage.

Discover art in the heart of Historic Downtown Grapevine. Walk the public art trail and experience Grapevine's bronze sculptures, art galleries and crafting stores. Experience late 19th century farm life at Nash Farm and connect with the agricultural heritage of the Grape Vine Prairie.

Visit the poignant 9/11 Flight Crew Memorial, on sacred ground, dedicated to the 33 flight crewmembers that were lost. This memorial is important to the history of aviation; it remembers the lost and honors those who continue the quest for excellence in the skies each day.

See the Grapevine Vintage Railroad - located in the heart of Historic Downtown Grapevine, offering unique experience on authentic, air-conditioned 1920s Victorian coaches. Stop by the Torian Cabin, the oldest structure in Grapevine, which is constructed of hand-hewn logs and is a recorded Texas Historic Landmark.
